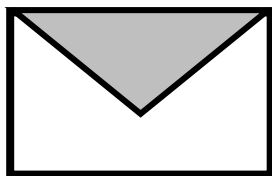

Acceptable Donations Include

- Appliances – Good, clean working order and less than 15 years old
- Artwork & Home Decor – Pictures and home décor accessories
- Cabinets – Clean, sets, singles, kitchen & bath
- Doors & Windows – Complete & functional (no aluminum windows/doors)
- Flooring – Tile, **hardwood**, laminate & vinyl (complete boxes)
- Furniture – Good condition (no rips, stains or pet hair, smoke free environment)
- Lighting – Lamps, fixtures, ceiling fans, light globes, security lighting
- Plumbing Supplies – Tubs, sinks, faucets, toilets, plumbing supplies
- Tools & Hardware – Hand & power tools, miscellaneous hardware, electrical supplies
- Roofing, Siding & Lumber
- Miscellaneous – Lawn mowers, edging stones, block, granite slabs, lawn equipment

Items we cannot accept include:

- Paint, stain, building compounds or hazardous material
- Electronics - Including computers, printers, copiers, shredders, stereos, speakers, & projectors etc.
- Small kitchen appliances unless they are new or in pristine condition
- Water Heaters
- Pianos or Organs
- Fluorescent lighting or bulbs
- Mattresses, box springs or bedding
- Carpeting or rugs unless brand new
- Baby furniture
- Hollow core doors
- No items with missing parts or pieces
- No items in non-sellable condition
- Any item that is overstocked at the time
