- Electric Appliances – Clean and in working order. Must be less than 15 years old.
- Gas appliances less than 2 years old
- Water Heaters — New in packaging
- Dishwashers — New in packaging
- Plumbing Supplies — Sinks, faucets, toilets, etc.
- Standard bathtubs — Like new condition
- Hot Tubs and Whirlpool tubs — New in packaging
- Cabinets — Both Kitchen and bath, either sets or singles.
- Laminate countertops — Must not be cut or angled and must be in like new condition
- Vanity tops — Like new condition
- Flooring — Tile, hardwood, laminate, and vinyl in complete boxes
- Trim — New in package
- Carpet — New in package
- Rugs — Like new condition
- Doors and Windows — Must be complete and functional
- Blinds — New in packaging
- Lighting — Lamps, fixtures, ceiling fans, light globes, and security lighting
- Furniture — No rips, stains, or pet hair. Must be from a smoke free environment.
- Tools and hardware
- Artwork and Home Décor

Unacceptable Items:

- Paint, stain, building compounds or other potentially hazardous materials
- Gas appliances older than 2 years or fireplaces
- Fluorescent lighting
- Hollow core doors
- Mattresses, box springs, waterbeds, futons, sleeper sofas
- Clothing, bedding, curtains
- Used carpet or rugs
- Kids toys
- Baby furniture
- Medical equipment and furniture
- Laminate vanity sink tops
- Unframed mirrors
- Glass shower doors
- Used small kitchen appliances
- Entertainment centers
- Electronics — Computers, printers, copiers, shredders, stereos, speakers, monitors, TVs, etc.
- Tires
- Pianos or Organs
- Any items with missing parts
